## Horizontal Colorful Hearts In a row Patch Free Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS:Size 5 DMC Pearl Cotton Thread in the following colors: Cream (Cr), Red, Orange (Or), Blue (Bl) and Gold, you also need a size O (zero) crochet hook.

FINISHED SIZE: 4" X 1-1 12 "
Please note: Throughout the instructions you are to carry the unused background thread behind sts as you work picking up and dropping the heart colors as indicated but not stated.

## PATCH:

ROW 1: With Cream and O hook ch-34, sc $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. ( 33 sts )
ROW 2: Cr sc next 2 sts, join Gold, sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next st, Gold sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next 5 sts, join Bl, sc next st, Cr sc next 5 sts, join Or, sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next st, Or sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next 5 sts, join Red, sc next st, Cr sc last 4 sts, ch-1, turn.
ROW 3: Cr sc next 4 sts, Red sc next st, Cr sc next 5 sts, Or sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next st, Or sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next 5 sts, Bl sc next st, Cr sc next 5 sts, Gold sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next st, Gold sc next 2 sts, Cr sc last 2 sts, ch-1, turn.
ROW 4: Cr sc next st, Gold sc next 7 sts, Cr sc next 3 sts, Bl sc next 3 sts, Cr sc next 3 sts, Or sc next 7 sts, Cr sc next 3 sts, Red sc next 3 sts, Cr sc next 3 last, ch-1, turn.
ROW 5: Cr sc next 2 sts, Red sc next 5 sts, Cr sc next 2 sts, Or sc next 7 sts, Cr sc next 2 sts, Bl sc next 5 sts, Cr sc next 2 sts, Gold sc next 7 sts, Cr sc last st, ch-1, turn.
ROW 6: Cr sc next 2 sts, Gold sc next 5 sts, Cr sc next 2 sts, Bl sc next 7 sts, Cr sc next 2 sts, Or sc next 5 sts, Cr sc next 2 sts, Red sc next 7 sts, Cr sc last st, ch-1, turn.
ROW 7: Cr sc next st, Red sc next 7 sts, Cr sc next 3 sts, Or sc next 3 sts, Cr sc next 3 sts, Bl sc next 7 sts, Cr sc next 3 sts, Gold sc next 3 sts, Cr sc last 3 sts, ch-1, turn.
ROW 8: Cr sc next 4 sts, Gold sc next st, Cr sc next 5 sts, Bl sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next st, Bl sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next 5 sts, Or sc next st, Cr sc next 5 sts, Red sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next st, Red sc next 2 sts, Cr sc last 2 sts, ch-1, turn.
ROW 9: Cr sc next 2 sts, Red sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next st, Red sc next 2 sts, fasten off Red, Cr sc next 5 sts, Or sc next st, fasten off Or, Cr sc next 5 sts, Bl sc next 2 sts, Cr sc next st, Bl sc next 2 sts, fasten off $\mathrm{Bl}, \mathrm{Cr}$ sc next 5 sts, Gold sc next st, fasten off Gold, Cr sc last 4 sts, ch-1, turn.
ROW 10: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.
RND 11: Sc ea st and row around working 2 sc in ea corner, sl st top beg sc, fasten off.

## USING THE PATCH:

You can sew or glue (no-sew glue) the patches to pants, shirts, hats, purses, etc. You can also make longer and turn into a belt, curtain tie back or even use 4 ply yarns to make a pillow or afghan.
